

Evangelizing through Prayer

Prayer is powerful. St. Therese of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face (a 19th century cloistered nun) is a beautiful witness to that power. She is often referred to as "The Little Flower." She became the patron saint of



Catholic missions though she never went on a physical mission herself. "The Little Flower" prayed instead! She may not have ever left her monastery, but she had a special love of missions and prayed.

"From her little cell, as from a broadcasting station, wonderful waves escape night and day. The souls whom they reach are unaware of their origin. They merely murmur: 'Someone has prayed for me.' [The Story of a Soul, 78]

We have all received the same mission to evangelize: "You are the light of the world" (Mt 5:14), "Go out to the whole world, proclaim the Good News to all creation" (Mk 16:15). Some Media Missionaries never go on physical missions or leave their home, but like St. Therese, they pray instead and fulfill that missionary calling!

"Missionaries, in fact—of whom Therese is patroness—are not only those who travel long distances, learn new languages, do good works, and are good at proclamation; no, a missionary is anyone who lives as an instrument of God's love where they are. Missionaries are those who do everything so that, through their witness, their prayer, their intercession, Jesus might pass by." ~ Pope Francis

EWTN is so blessed to have Media Missionaries who Evangelize through Prayer; they may not be able to go out to distant places or even their local parish but they pray for the Network and souls the world over right where they are, and indeed that is a great blessing to all of us. Thank you.

Compelling Evangelistic Quotes from Pope Francis'

The Joy of the Gospel - Apostolic Exhortation

As each of us embark daily in our missioning, let us reflect on five compelling quotes from Pope Francis to inspire and encourage our evangelization with those we encounter:

"The joy of the gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus. Those who accept his offer of salvation are set free from sin, sorrow, inner emptiness and loneliness. With Christ joy is constantly born anew."

"I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day. The Lord does not disappoint those who take this risk; whenever we take a step towards Jesus, we come to realize that he is

already there, waiting for us with open arms."

"In virtue of their baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples (cf. Mt 28:19). All the

baptized, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelization."

"Every Christian is challenged, here and now, to be actively engaged in evangelization; indeed, anyone who has truly experienced God's saving love does not need much time or lengthy training to go out and proclaim that love. Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus: we no longer say that we are 'disciples' and 'missionaries,' but rather that we are always 'missionary disciples.""

Let us hear and heed the compelling words of Pope Francis as he echoes the teaching of Christ and the Apostles down through the ages for every member of the church to evangelize. Whether you are homebound or active, you are still a missionary disciple. Let us proclaim

Saint Therese of the Child of Jesus and the Holy Face once learned of a criminal, Enrico Pranzini was sentenced to death for horrible crimes, but he did not want to receive the consolations of the faith. Therese prayed in every way for his conversion, not leaving the monastery.

The execution took place. The next day, Therese read in the newspaper that Pranzini, just before laying his head on the block, "all of a sudden, seized by a sudden inspiration, turned around, grabbed a Crucifix that the priest handed to him and kissed

three times the sacred wounds" of Jesus.

"As an EWTN Media Missionary, I realize I can help to bring people to their salvation. What could more important than that? Nothing!"

"I was in crisis and had family challenges when my husband passed 35 years ago. Daily, on my way to my job at the hospital I would visit a bakery where a friend of mine worked. She told me about EWTN because she knew of my situation, "You got to listen to EWTN, that will really help you!" So I would tune in to EWTN on radio and it became my consolation and my refuge from my loneliness and situation. It led me to deepen my faith and belief in God's presence and to just be touched by the light of the Holy Spirit, especially in trying times.
